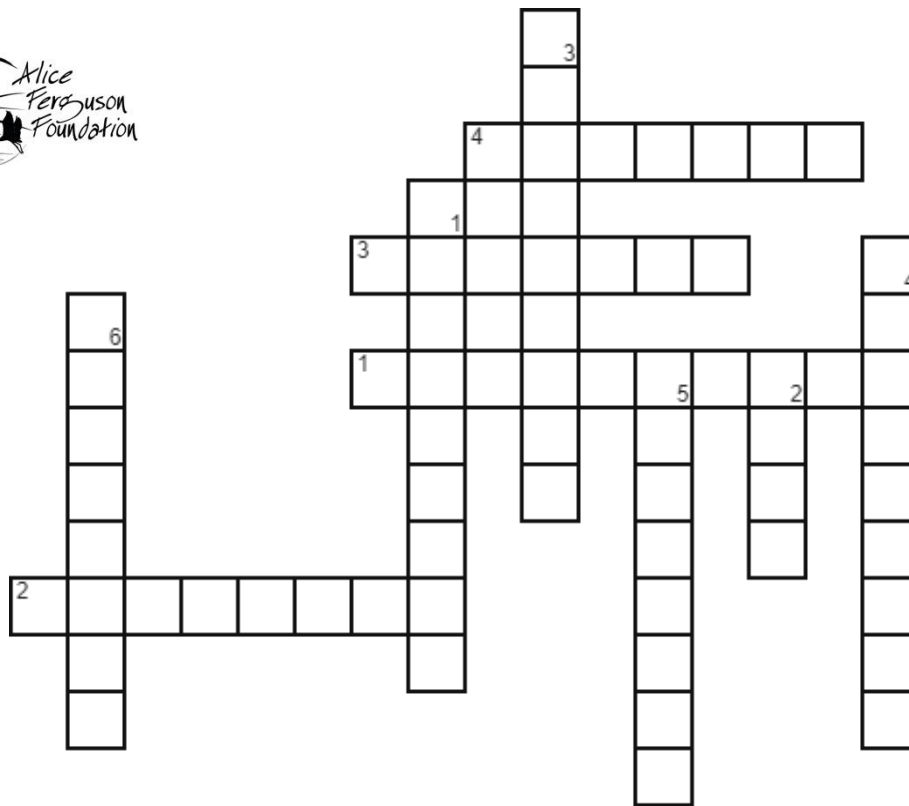


Alice Ferguson Foundation Nature Crossword Puzzle

Across

1. An organism that breaks down dead or decaying organisms (ex. Fungi, Bacteria, some Invertebrates)
2. Animal that eats both meat and plants
3. The natural home or environment for an animal, plant or other organism (ex. Marsh)
4. The breaking down and moving of soil by water and other natural processes.

Down

1. The land and small bodies of water that flow water into larger bodies of water (ex. Potomac River)
2. A mixture of broken-down rocks, decayed organic material, air and water where plants grow.
3. Animal that only eats meat
4. Animal that only eats plants
5. A living creature that creates its own food from the air, light, soil, and water
6. A living creature that gets its food from other living creatures
