Clothing and Gear

This is an outdoor all weather program. Help your child have a wonderful experience by dressing for the weather.

Please be sure your children wears:

- Comfortable closed toe shoes (that can get dirty).
- Long pants.
- Dress in layers for cold weather, including a warm coat, hat and gloves.
- Rain gear if rain is in the forecast.

Teach your child to enjoy the outside by being prepared. There is no such thing as bad weather, only bad clothes.

Plan a Trash Free Visit

We encourage our visitors to bring a trash free lunch. Here are some ideas!

- Use a refillable water bottle and lunch box.
- Bring food in reusable containers or food that needs no container (like an apple).
- Reduce the amount of disposable packaging used (use recyclable packages).
